Metros have a reputation for being excellent hosts, with great organisation, superb post-race refreshments and many encouraging marshals on the 10km Road Run and the Tenderfoot run within the park.

We need most help during the 10km run ie from 9.15 am to 10.30 am. However, if your time is limited, help with any part of the morning would be appreciated.

All individual runners are graded in age bands – children under 14 are graded per year and adults over 40 are graded in 5-year age bands. All participants score points for their club. There is an additional Metros trophy for the best overall adult Metros runner in the Summer League.

10.45 am 1.5 km 'Tenderfoot' race for children & beginners, within the park

11.15 am Fun Run (approx. 400m) within the park.

11.25 am Relays (approx. 400m) within the park.
